### Say This

Who has a plan for you? *God has a plan for you.*

### Do This



#### Morning Time

When you go into your baby's room, pick them up, smile and say, "God loves you so much, even more than I do. And that's A LOT!"



#### Feeding Time

While feeding your baby this month, look them in the eyes and say, "God has a plan for you to do good things. I wonder what good things you will do."



#### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your baby this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You that part of Your plan for me was to be (name of baby)'s (mom, dad). Help me to trust Your plans, not only for me but for (him, her) as well. I love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen."



#### Bath Time

As you bathe your baby, sing the following words to the tune of Mary Had a Little Lamb:

"God has a plan for you and me, you and me, you and me.  
God has a plan for you and me; just you wait an see."

Just like learning to walk, talk, self-feed, and potty-train, preschoolers can learn the skill of making and keeping friends.

Pharaoh puts Joseph in charge of saving grain after Joseph helps him understand his dreams.

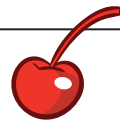
### Week Four

## Preschool

DAILY CUES



### Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning, (name of child)! God has good things planned for us to do today!"



### Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, say to your child, "Do you remember how Joseph was a helper in the Bible story? Let's take turns saying different things we can do to help others."



### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for planning good things for us to do. Help us to look for the good, even when bad things are happening. You always have something good planned for us to do! We love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen."



### Bath Time

Add plastic water and land animals to bath time. Talk about God's plan for each animal. Some were made to swim in water (bath water) and others were made to walk on land (side of tub). Tell your child to sort the animals by water and land. Talk about how God loves people the best, and He has a plan for us too!

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**Say This**

**Genesis 37-45**

Joseph continues to trust God’s plan throughout hardships, and God uses him to save many people.

**Do This**



**Morning Time**

When you go into your child’s room, say, “Good morning! I see someone God loves, and (his, her) name is . . . (say your child’s name as you pick them up or tickle their tummy).”



**Cuddle Time**

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, “Dear God, thank You that Your plan was for us to be a family. Thank You for (name the people in your immediate family). Help us to be kind to one another. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name. Amen.”



**Drive Time**

As you drive or take a walk, say to your child, “Do you remember how Joseph was a helper in the Bible story? Let’s look for helpers outside. If you see someone helping, say, ‘helper!’”



**Bath Time**

Add a plastic bowl and a measuring cup to bath time. Tell your child to use the measuring cup to scoop and pour the water into the bowl, like Joseph scooped and poured the grain.

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
